

Supported Living train the trainer



This is the only course of its kind in the UK. It is specifically aimed at people who already have some personal experience of implementing Supported Living and who wish to have a framework for incorporating their experiences into a training course which helps promote Supported Living and develop a broader understanding.

This course will teach delegates how to train people in Supported Living. The course will be led by Peter Kinsella and incorporate the combined experiences of Peter and Paradigms' other Supported Living consultants, Simon Duffy and Richard Williams who have all played significant leadership roles in developing Supported Living in the UK. Each course is identical.

Context

The White Paper, and Scottish Review, strongly promote Person Centred approaches and Supported Living, in particular. If services are to respond to these demanding expectations, they will need to develop strong internal capacity to spread their early learning. This course seeks to give organisations an opportunity to do this around Supported Living.

Who it's for
