Reach Support for LIVING: An Introduction

This workshop, co-facilitated by Sally Warren (MD Paradigm) and an Expert by Experience, will introduce you to Reach resource pack. The Reach Standards are the only nationally recognised standards for Supported Living and welcomed by both local commissioners and Care Quality Commission.

In this practical workshop we will bring the resource to life, share tips, inspire and challenge each other to stay focused on the true principles of Support for LIVING.

Launched in November 2013 Reach: Support for living an ordinary life was developed to:

- clarify the standards of support for living to ensure that 'supported living' doesn't become a model that people can simply tick as 'achieved'.
- ensure that in the current climate of dwindling financial resources and tightening budgets, we remain committed to quality support
- show how Reach can be useful to people with direct payments or personal budgets

The course explores :

- how both the It's My Life and the Service review elements can be embedded to improve how you listen to all those supported to improve the quality of support
- your understanding of the eleven Reach standards and what needs to be seen, heard, felt or evidenced for each
- the free online resources available to support your use of Reach
- the principles of Support for Living (Supported Living)
- how Reach supports you evidencing with the CQC and the Care Act (2014) requirements

- an understanding of the fundamentals of how to bring Reach support for living to life
- a draft plan of action and team of people identified as the Reach Review team
- tips and skills to facilitate creative discussions engage a range of people in your organisation in your Reach reviews
- an understanding of how to facilitate a Reach support for living review in your agency
